<a href="#">OWWCO – MECP Director Approved Training for Water and Wastewater Operators</a>	Most courses if they are directly related to water, wastewater or stormwater and not general leadership or health and safety
<a href="#">Association of Consulting Engineers (ACEC) – Engineering CPD Courses</a>	Civil, Environmental or Project Management disciplines – various courses that are related to managing water/wastewater/stormwater contracts

<a href="#">Acclaims Environmental</a>	Environmental Compliance; Management Systems; Onsite Audits;

On the Job (OTJ) Training, or Attendance at Workshops, Seminars or Conferences	Must be provided by a known organization, or qualified instructor and has clearly defined learning outcomes related to water, ww or swm and attendance and duration of event can be verified. Contact <a href="mailto:certify@oacett.org">certify@oacett.org</a> for a template.
<a href="#">Alison</a> - Self-study - Free on-line courses	One-day (7-hour) and multi-day courses are acceptable, provided they cover the same subject matter and are relevant to Municipal Infrastructure. Maximum of 5 days can be credited.
<a href="#">Association of Ontario Road Supervisors (AORS)</a>	Courses with the “ <b>MI approved</b> ” badge next to it are recognized towards academic requirements for the OACETT Municipal Infrastructure designation.
<p><b>**Final approval of courses rests with the Registrar and the Admissions Committee. All courses are subject to maximum allowable credit limits and must have been completed in 2000 or later.</b></p>
